SISTER SOCIETY AGREEMENT



The International Compumag Society and the IEEE Magnetics Society have recently signed the Sister Society Agreement. The objective of the IEEE Sister Society Program is to encourage the exchange and dissemination of technical information, and to promote understanding and cooperation between the members of the Societies.

The Memorandum of Understanding between the two Societies is now in force under the above Program for the next three years when it will need to be renewed. Under this MoU the two societies remain completely independent, but there is encouragement to cooperate. The MoU was signed by the Bruce Terris, the President of the IEEE Magnetics Society, and Arnulf Kost, the President of the International Compumag Society. Under the terms of this agreement the Magnetics Society will consider proposals for "in cooperation" (technical) sponsorship of the main ICS conference Compumag, taking place every other year, in which the Magnetics Society is not a financial cosponsor, and will continue its support of the post-conference special issue publications after each Compumag conference, as has been the tradition for the past many years. The ICS and the Magnetics Society

may also, subject to agreement on specific items, enter into joint projects, events, and products such as conferences, forums, publications, electronic publishing initiatives, history observations, standards, educational materials.
