


Elections to the Board of the ICS

In accordance with the Society's Constitution and Bye-Laws, every three years there are elections to the Board of the Society, where half of the current members retire and candidates are nominated so that voting can take place. The retiring members are eligible to be re-elected. Members of the Society vote for the candidates from their region. On pages 13 to 18 of this Newsletter you will find short biographies and statements of all candidates. Please read them carefully before you cast your vote. The Board plays an important role in setting up the strategy and policy of the Society, so this is your chance to influence such decisions.

The voting itself will take place over summer, and you will be receiving e-mail messages in due course and instructions how to vote. It is expected that the deadline for voting will be towards the end of September so that the successful candidates will be announced in the November issue of the ICS Newsletter.
